



Hey GO Team!

Come join us on a trip to Punta Gorda, Belize! Punta Gorda, the southernmost town in Belize, is home to over 5,000 people from the many different ethnic groups found throughout the Toledo District. While Punta Gorda remains a fairly sleepy little town except for market days, it is now increasingly used as a base for the inland and marine activities. It is the perfect location to share and show the good news of Jesus.

Our team will be participating in a medical clinic, treating patients and partnering with Toledo Faith Outreach Christian Church to share the gospel. Additionally, we will partner to do ministry projects that will serve specific needs of this community. We will travel to village areas to play with and teach the children, lead church services, and bless the people in a variety of ways.



Our Belize mission is typically 5 days (Thursday-Monday), and ranges between \$1850 and \$1950, which will include flights (round trip to Belize City as well as to Punta Gorda), 4 nights in a hotel, food, ground transportation, medical supplies, mission materials, etc.

We welcome you to join us after the mission for a (3) day extended stay on the beach for fun, fins and fellowship. Belize has amazing beaches and diving! Those additional costs will be shared. If you have any questions about the trip itinerary, please let us know.



What is a typical day on a GO Overflow Mission Trip?

While each mission is unique, and we can also tailor-make a trip for a specific group, there are some aspects of each mission experience that are replicated. During our 4 to 5 day missions, you can expect to participate in the following:

- Morning devotions led by Team leaders/team members
- Door to door evangelism within local villages, in partnership with churches (you will be trained, and will participate as you are comfortable)
- Worship services and small group discussion (discipleship) at local churches
- Minor construction projects (painting, basic building, cleaning)
- Medical screening, basic medical clinics, and educational teaching on preventative care (roles assigned based on expertise, more involvement for “medical focus” teams)
- Teaching and games with children at local orphanages/schools
- Activity/excursion in the local community (snorkeling, rafting, etc.)

Who does GO Overflow work with in country?

Partnerships with local ministries is a key component of GO Overflow; we work with churches and non-profits within the local communities who are already actively helping those in need. GO Overflow offers year-round support to our partners, through business partnerships, project-focused finances, child sponsorships, and visiting mission teams. We help to further the ongoing work that is happening, broadening the reach and scope of those ministering daily in local communities.

How do I sign up for a trip?

You can fill out a trip application form for a particular mission on our website under the “Get Involved” tab or email us at info@go-overflow.org. We are happy to answer any questions you might have, and if you are ready to commit to a mission, we’ll let you know next steps. A \$200 non-refundable deposit is due 90 days prior to the departure of the mission, and 50% of the balance is due 60 days prior to departure, or when airline reservations are secured (potentially sooner).
